

# Christmas Activity

## DIY Ornaments

Due to the pandemic, there have been very few things to do this year to get into the holiday spirit. Let's spice up the holiday season and make some ornaments at home. All you need is a few materials!

### Materials:

\* you can get all of these at the dollar store \*

- Ornament containers
- Any centerpiece item that can be the centerpiece of the globe
  - Recommendations: a nice cute plant outside, a painted rock, a small toy lying around
- Ribbon
- Yarn
- Tissue paper
- Hot glue gun
- Additional: mod podge and glitter

Steps:

1. Gather all your materials.



2. Open the ornament container and measure out a place to put the centerpiece. I chose a red tree as my centerpiece.
3. Glue the centerpiece object to the middle of the lid.
4. Crumple up some paper and glue it to the bottom of the lid, to act like snow.
5. Addition: paint the inside with mod podge and sprinkle some glitter inside to act like little snow flakes
6. Close up the ornament.
7. Wrap yarn on the lid to hide the metal part and add more color to your design!
8. Lace ribbon on the top to add a cute hanger for the ornaments and you can hang it on the tree
