Is Your School Eligible?

Eligible School must be located in an area:

- In Santa Clara County
AND
- Have a CalEnviroScreen score greater than 33
OR
- Have a Distressed Community Index score greater than 50
OR
- Have a Regional Opportunity Index (People or Place) that is below the state average
OR
- Have a community-wide unemployment rate above the current state average
